- Respect equality and the rights, dignity and worth of all people involved in the Society, regardless of gender, ethnicity, marital status, disability, sexuality, age, occupation, religion or political opinion.
- Conduct themselves in a manner which does not damage or undermine the reputation of the Society and not take part in any activity which is in conflict with the objects of the Society, or which might damage the reputation of the Society.

Serious misconduct by members will be dealt with under the **Dealing with Misconduct of Members Procedure**.
